

The Lutherhaus Eisenach for Tour Groups



The Lutherhaus Eisenach is a cultural history museum, one of the most important sites of Reformation memory and an official European cultural heritage site. It memorializes Martin Luther's sojourn in Eisenach during his schooldays (1498–1501) and his historic Translation of the Bible, which he started at Wartburg Castle near Eisenach in 1521.

Highlights:

- The historic building: one of the oldest and loveliest surviving secular half-timbered building in Thuringia
- Award-winning permanent exhibition and special exhibition in German and English
- The sculpture man in a cube by Ai Weiwei as a permanent installation
- Cultural education: hands-on workshops for groups of all ages (advance registration required)

Permanent exhibition "Luther and the Bible"







(2015, partially redesigned and expanded in 2022) on the history of Martin Luther's translation of the Bible and its effective history down to the twenty-first century: The exhibition presents numerous historical objects from the fourteenth to the twenty-first century on approximately 700 m2, including significant medieval carvings, precious items from the "Römhild textile trove", works by Lucas Cranach and the parish register with the entry recording Johann Sebastian Bach's baptism as well as numerous audio stations, informational graphics, animated films and interactive media stations.



Special exhibition (until the end of 2023)



"Study and Eradication: The Church's "Dejudaization Institute", 1939–1945 (2019, expanded in 2022) on the backstory, work and aftermath of the "Institute for the Study and Eradication of Jewish Influence on German Church Life" established in Eisenach in 1939.

Visual art



The sculpture "man in a cube" by Ai Weiwei (*1957), created as a rumination on Luther's treatise On the Freedom of a Christian for the 2017 quincentenary of the Reformation, on permanent display in the courtyard of the Lutherhaus Eisenach since 2020.

The Lutherhaus Eisenach is located in the center of Eisenach (Free State of Thuringia), not far from the Marktplatz.

Bus Parking

A drop off/pick up zone for registered tour groups, where visitors can easily get on and off their buses, is located next to the Lutherhaus Eisenach. A bus parking lot is located just 200 meters away on Frauenplan near the Bachhaus.

Information for Your Booking

So that your visit to the Lutherhaus is as pleasant as possible, we recommend that you register visits with groups of ten or more in advance.

Group Size

A group comprises no fewer than 10 and no more than 30 individuals. We recommend splitting up larger groups and entering the museum at roughly fifteen-minute intervals minutes.

Guided Tours

The permanent exhibition and the special exhibition are each designed to be self-guided and seen by visitors on their own. Alternatively, you can book a guided tour through our exhibitions (groups of 25 or fewer, time approximately 45 minutes) in advance. Curator-guided tours can also be arranged. - free WLAN in the foyer,
- use of the seating in the museum shop and the courtyard,

- a chance to browse in the Lutherhaus's museum shop.

Free Admission

- Seating and coffee and snacks vending machines are located in the entry area.
 Food and beverages may only be consumed in the foyer (seating area). Some seating is located in the exhibition galleries.
- Lockers can be used with euro coins.
- WLAN is available to visitors free of charge.
- Restrooms are located in the basement (ladies: 2 stalls; gentlemen: 2 urinals and 1 stall) and on the ground floor (1 wheelchair accessible stall).
- A baby changing table is available.
- Our museum shop offers a wide range of Lutherhaus exhibition catalogues, further literature on the subjects of the exhibitions, exclusive Lutherhaus products, Bibles and souvenirs.



Museum Rules

- Pictures may be taken for personal use at the Lutherhaus Eisenach without flash or tripod.
- With the exception of guide dogs, animals may not be taken into the museum.
- Food and beverages may not be taken into the exhibition galleries or the courtyard.
- Smoking is prohibited everywhere inside the museum including the courtyard.
- Outerwear, umbrellas, backpacks and purses larger than DIN A 4 (20×30 cm) must be left at the coat check or in a locker.

Video Surveillance

The museum's premises are monitored by video camera to protect visitors and exhibited objects.
